Alpharetta High School PTSA Scholarships

To that end, the Alpharetta High School PTSA is pleased to announce its Student Scholarship Program for 2011-2012. The PTSA scholarships are designed to recognize outstanding AHS seniors who have demonstrated exceptional leadership, outstanding school and community involvement, and the ability to complete a strong academic program.

Scholarships are available to the AHS Class of 2012. These scholarships are only available to AHS seniors who are PTSA members, thanks to generous contributions by PTSA members and by corporate sponsors.

Minimum Criteria. These scholarships are competitive. Check each box below to verify that you meet the minimum qualifications:

- Current enrollment as AHS senior
- Academic achievement with a cumulative average of 85 or higher
- Good citizenship as demonstrated by no ISS or OSS suspensions at AHS
- Progress toward graduation with appropriate credits to graduate on time
- PTSA Member (*due no later than February 13, 2012*)

Additional Criteria. Successful applicants will also demonstrate the following:

- Completion of a rigorous academic program
- Demonstrated responsibility within the school and/or community
- Commitment to service through participation in scholastic and/or community organizations
- Commitment to academics, athletics, and the arts

Note: Financial need is NOT a part of the application process; this is a merit scholarship
